
RESOLUTION NO. 6 OF 2000

AMENDMENT OF CLAUSES 6.2 AND 8.2 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELFARE SECTOR BARGAINING COUNCIL

The parties to the Public Health and Welfare Sector Bargaining Council hereby resolve:

- 1. To abide by the Court Order dated 11 May 2000.
- To amend clause 6.2 (i) of the Constitution of the Public Health and Welfare
 Sector Bargaining Council, as stipulated by the Court Order dated 11 May 2000,
 to read: "must admit the applicant trade union if it has at least 10 000 members in
 good standing in the public health and welfare sector"
- 3. To amend clause 8.2 of the Constitution of the Public Health and Welfare Sector Bargaining Council to read: "The trade unions in the Council may each be represented by two representatives for the first threshold of 10 000 members, then one additional representative for every additional 10 000 members or part thereof up to a maximum of 5 representatives. A trade union may appoint any person to represent it in the Council, depending upon the issues that are to be discussed in the Council and up to the number designated to it in terms of this clause."
- 4. This agreement binds:
- 4.1 The Employer.
- 4.2 All the employees who fall within the registered scope of Council.
- 5. The agreement shall come into effect from the date of signing.
